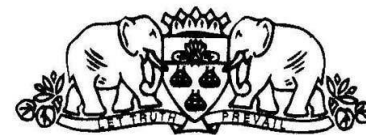

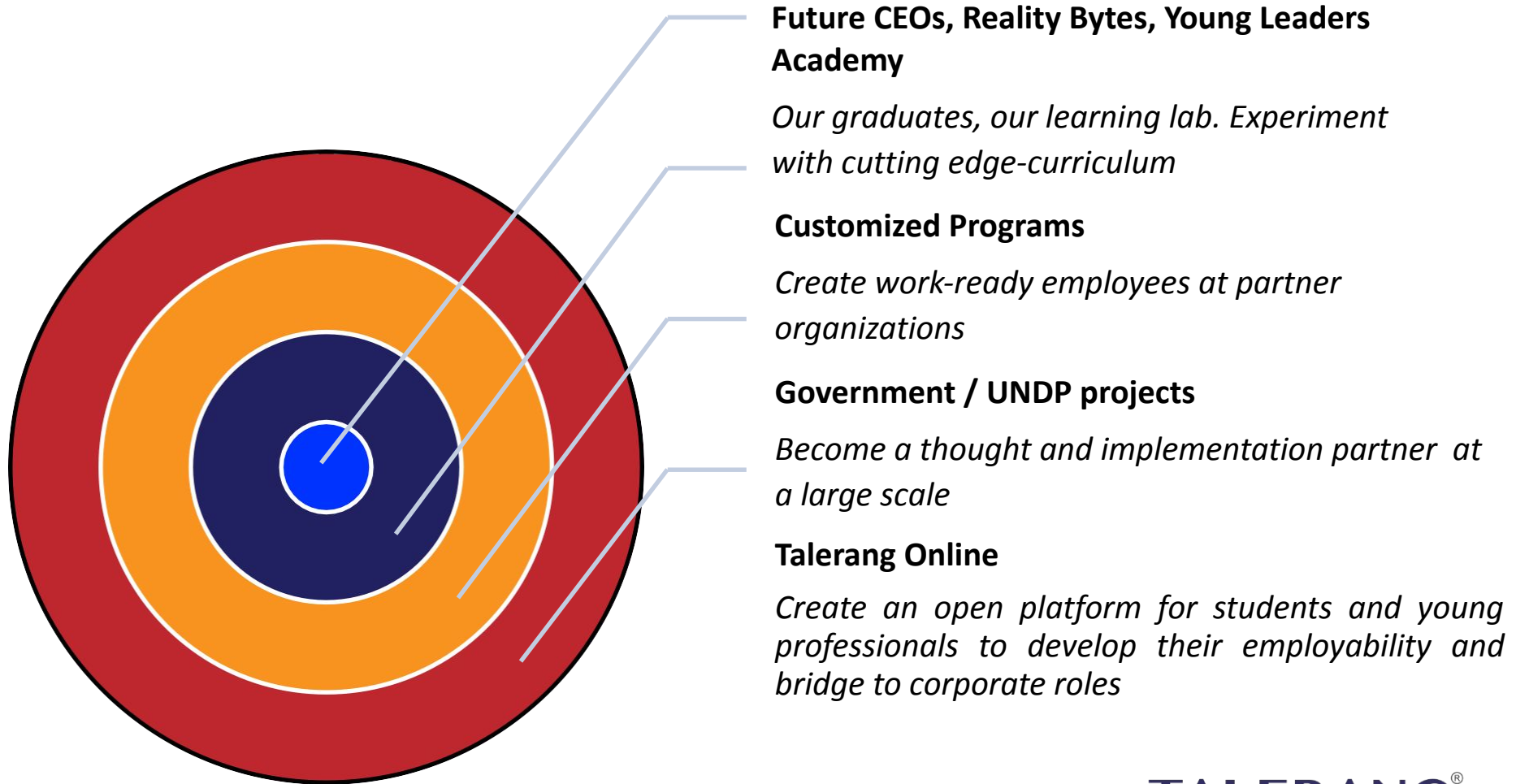

अर्थव्यवस्था को विकास की राह पर ले जाना चाहते हैं, तो हमें छोटे कस्बों तक नौकरियों की पहुंच को बेहतर बनाना होगा। पिछले सप्ताह आंध्रप्रदेश में एक एम्प्लॉयबिलिटी रिसर्च स्टडी के दौरान हमें विशाखापत्तनम और विजयवाड़ा के कुछ कॉलेजों में जाने का मौका मिला। यह स्टडी हार्वर्ड यूनिवर्सिटी और स्टैनफोर्ड यूनिवर्सिटी के प्रोफेसर और शिक्षा मंत्रालय द्वारा मिलकर आयोजित की गई थी। हमें एक हजार ऐसे छात्रों से मिलने का मौका मिला, जो जल्द ही प्लेसमेंट प्रक्रिया का हिस्सा बनने वाले थे। जैसी कि संभावना थी, छोटे कस्बों के छात्रों में अब भी रूढ़िवादी मानसिकता का प्रभाव देखने को मिलता है, लेकिन इसके बावजूद वे बाहरी रिसर्चर और ट्रेनर का खुले दिल से स्वागत करते हैं।

हम कुछ कॉलेजों के प्लेसमेंट हेड से मिले और उनकी सोच को समझने की कोशिश की। पता चला कि उन्हें कॉलेजों में प्लेसमेंट करवाने के लिए कंपनियों के एचआर ऑफिस को कई बार विजिट करना पड़ता है। अपने कॉलेज के छात्रों को जॉब दिलाने के लिए काफी मेहनत करनी पड़ती है।

कोर ब्रांचेस में ज्यादा हो नौकरियां

जब आंध्र प्रदेश में कॉलेज सेट अप किए जा रहे थे तब भारत में मैनुफैक्चरिंग सेक्टर में ज्यादा नौकरियां थीं, लेकिन आईटी सेक्टर के बढ़ने के बाद कॉलेज में जो कंपनियां जॉब प्लेसमेंट के लिए आ रही हैं, वे सॉफ्टवेयर डेवलपमेंट के लिए कैंडिडेट ढूंढती हैं, जबकि कॉलेज का ज्यादातर सिलेबस कोर सेक्टर पर आधारित है। कंपनियां जो चाहती

कम्युनिकेशन है बड़ी समस्या

छात्र एकेडमिकली बेहतर कर रहे हैं, अच्छे ग्रेड लेकर आते हैं और मेहनती भी हैं। लेकिन बड़े शहरों की अपेक्षा इनमें आत्मविश्वास की कमी होती है और इन्हें कम बढ़ावा दिया जाता है, लेकिन बेहतर ट्रेनिंग और मेंटरशिप से इसे बेहतर किया जा सकता है। जब हमने छात्रों से प्लेसमेंट के दौरान होने वाली परेशानियों के बारे में पूछा तो कम्युनिकेशन प्रॉब्लम, कॉन्फिडेंस की कमी और इंग्लिश पर कमजोर पकड़ को सबसे बड़ी समस्या बताया। मतलब यह है कि कॉलेज बेहतर कर रहे हैं और छात्रों के अंदर बेहतर करने की क्षमता है। कंपनियों को हायरिंग के लिए छोटे कस्बों की ओर भी बढ़ना होगा, न कि सिर्फ स्थापित कॉलेजों की ओर।

हैं और कॉलेजों में जो पढ़ाया जाता है, उसमें बहुत बड़ा गैप है। यदि हम मेक इन इंडिया को सफल बनाना चाहते हैं, तो हमें मैनुफैक्चरिंग सेक्टर में निवेश बढ़ाना होगा और इस सेक्टर में नई नौकरियां पैदा करनी होंगी।

सी आर रेड्डी कॉलेज ऑफ इंजीनियरिंग के प्लेसमेंट हेड के अनुसार यदि सरकार कोर इंजीनियरिंग में नौकरियों के बढ़ावे पर जोर देगी, तो वर्तमान हालात में यह सबसे बढ़िया हल होगा। हमें इंडस्ट्री की जरूरतों के हिसाब से अपना सिलेबस भी लगातार अपडेट करना होगा।

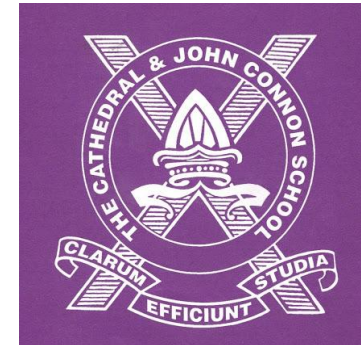
कंपनियां लड़कियों को भी दे रहीं अवसर

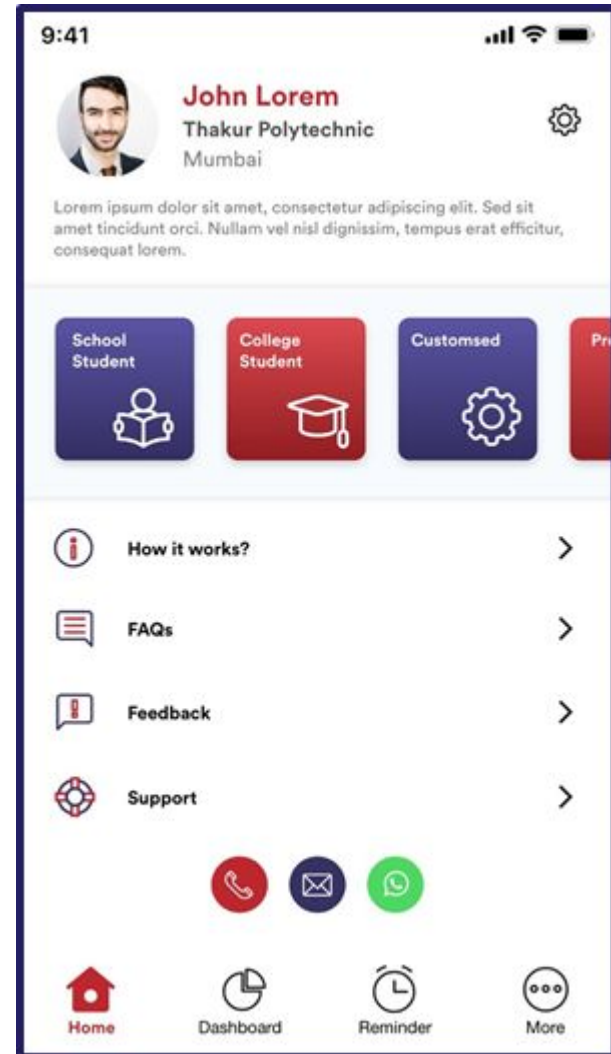

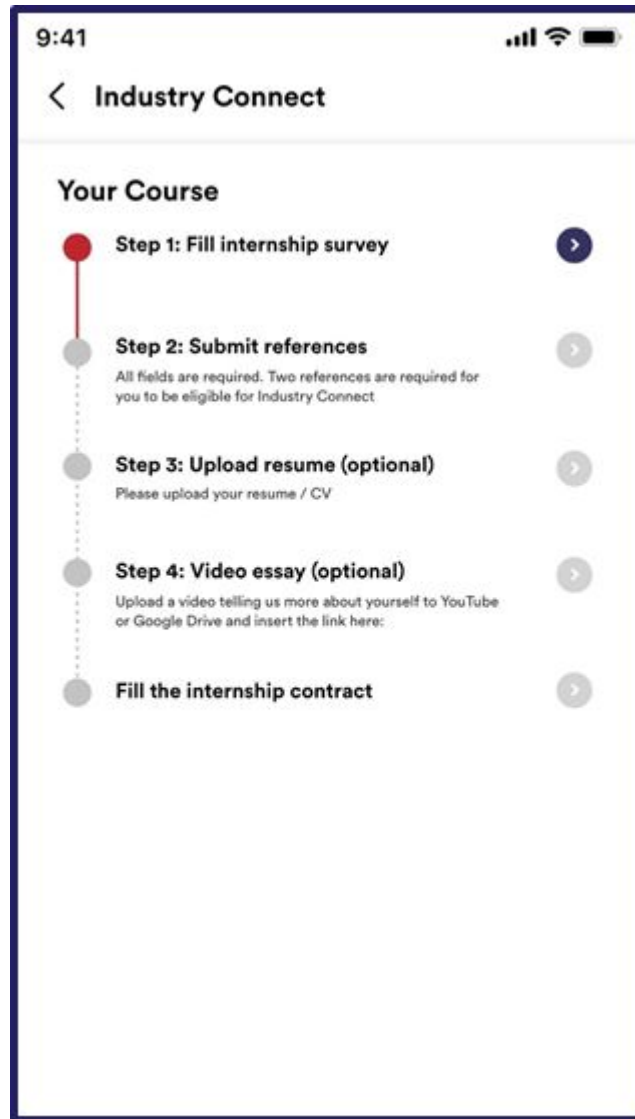

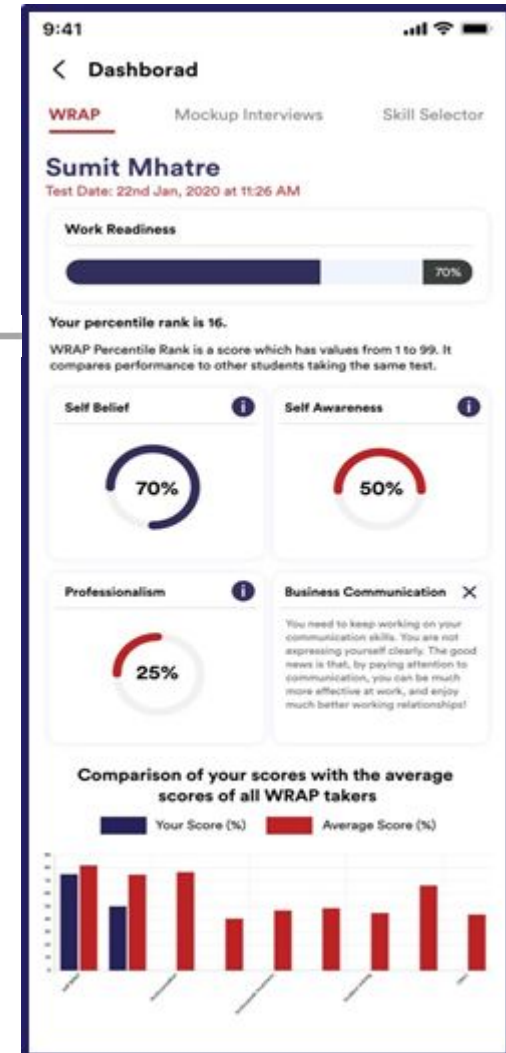
